As a worldwide business, what made you choose Gloucestershire as another base?

Before Moog established its operations in Gloucestershire, Bill Moog had met George Dowty and agreed that Dowty Rotol would manufacture the Moog products under licence back in the late 1950s – so when Moog decided to set up its own operation within the UK in 1963 Gloucestershire was already familiar ground: there was a capable workforce in place and the county was a good base for key markets.

How do you rate the Gloucestershire workforce?

Gloucestershire has a talented workforce particularly in the Advanced Engineering Sector. The county has benefited from large manufacturers who invested significantly in training through the 70s and 80s so there's a large cohort of very capable, experienced individuals at work in the county. Equally, the younger generation of graduates in the county, many of whom were educated in our excellent schools are leading the technical changes and innovation that characterise so much of what we do well in Gloucestershire.

Being such a niche industry, do you find local skilled staff hard to find?

Usually we are able to source staff locally or extend to the bordering counties and go as far as Birmingham or Bristol.

We do run an apprentice programme and currently have four apprentices.

Having created so many jobs in Gloucestershire, and brought so many to the area, what do your employees do here after hours?

There is no shortage of activities out of hours!

Gloucestershire's extremely well-placed to provide access to the wide range of activities necessary for a good work/life balance. We have all the great sporting activities on our doorstep: rugby, cricket, racing and access to fabulous walking and enjoying nature at its best. The festivals also provide great interest and enrichment.
